APPROACH

- Maintain the practice of “Never do anything unsafe” to ensure, where practicable, no adverse hazards or harm impact on the Company’s people or the environment when conducting business operations.
- Comply with all applicable legislation, Australian Standards, other responsible industry requirements to which Goldstar Transport subscribes and strive to meet ISO 9001, ISO14001 and ISO 45001
- Maintain a commitment to continual improvement of the HSEQ Management System to enhance performance and fulfilment of our compliance obligations and our commitment to eliminating HSEQ risks
- Develop methods of evaluating performance for continual improvement of the Company’s processes and behaviours when identifying and achieving HSEQ goals as part of the HSEQ Management Plan.
- Implement action plans and risk assessments which establish, monitor and maintain a safe workplace.
- Ensure all mobile vehicles, plant and equipment are maintained in good, safe and appropriate conditions at all times.
- Ensure employees are properly selected, qualified and educated in the Company’s HSEQ practices.
- Develop a culture which focuses on injury prevention, fitness for work responsibilities, waste minimisation, pollution control and accountability through transparent recording and reporting measures.
- Communicate this policy across the whole organisation by effectively utilising resources such as toolbox meetings, inductions, notice boards, electronic forms of communication, and / or other means as appropriate.

COMMITMENT, OBJECTIVES & TARGETS

This policy applies to all Goldstar Transport personnel, contractors, and visitors across all projects and operations at all times.
